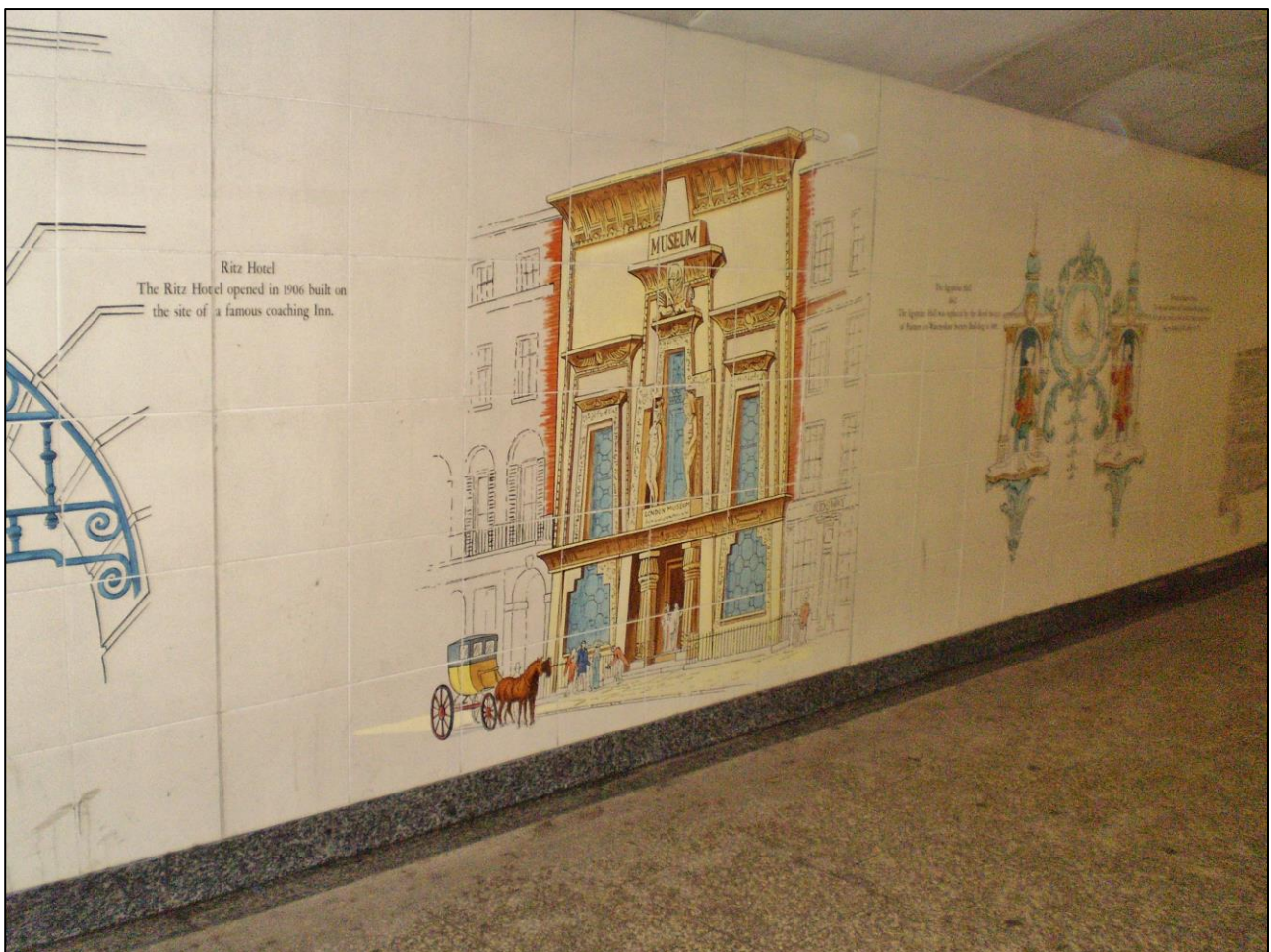


## The Egyptian Hall lives on underneath Hyde Park Corner
